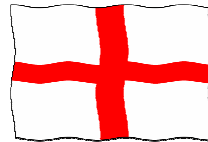
Personal Philosophy of Ministry

- Develop your own personal faith level: believing is seeing
- Confrontation is needful

- Be a decision maker
